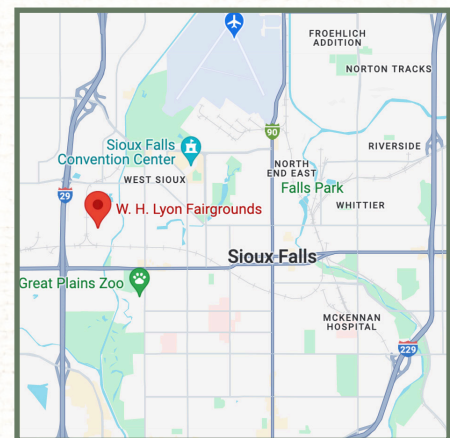

Rules and Regulations

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.

Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.

Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.

In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.

No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.

It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly pre-sented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience.

Horses and/or riders/drivers/handlers entered in opportunity classes can cross enter the rated/recognized divisions.

Safe Sport Statement Reminder: All USEF Members and Senior Life Active Members as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirements to be eligible to participate in competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Equine Vaccination Rule — At Federation-licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the horse show grounds. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. For more information refer to www.usef.org GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule.

Coggins — All horses exhibited or on the grounds must have had a coggins test within the 12 months prior to the show dates. The show office will require a copy. To expedite check-in, please send copies with your entries or have copies ready when checking in.

Horses — Include copies of registration papers for all horses entered. Horse's name must be entered as it appears on the registration papers. Enter all horse information requested on the entry form with one owner per entry form.

Trainers — Enter complete name, address, and contact phone number of trainer if other than owner. If there is no Trainer, then owner must sign again as trainer on back of entry.

Rider/Driver/Handler/Trainer Membership Cards — Include copies of current USEF and AHA competition cards for every rider/driver/handler/trainer. In the case of amateur classes, every Rider/Driver/Handler 19 & over, or in the case of 18 year olds as of Dec. 1st showing in Amateur Classes, must be amateur certified by USEF or apply in the show office before showing. A show pass for \$35 for AHA single event fee are available.

Signatures On Entry — Make sure all signatures are on the entry blank, including permission for minor to show box. A minor cannot sign the entry form anywhere; a parent or guardian, agent, or trainer must sign for a minor in required signature boxes, and then print the name of the minor under adult signature. If the adult is not showing and only signing for minor, AHA & USEF memberships are not required. Please include name, address, and date of birth for all minors.

USEF Show Pass Form — This form must be done online with USEF. As of 12/1/2022, only one Show Pass Form is allowed per competition year. If you have already submitted a Show Pass Form for the year, a competing membership is required.

Entries — Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Include check to cover all fees. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to fill out entries correctly. No packets will be given out until entries are complete. A \$50 returned check fee will be applied for any returned checks due to non-sufficient funds or cancellations. **EARLY ENTRIES CLOSE MARCH 29, 2024.**

Post Entries — Post entries must be brought to the show with all papers, coggins, and proof of vaccination. They must be completed with all signatures and all correct rider/driver/trainer cards. Please email the show manager ahead of arrival to allow for stalling of horses.

Return checks — A \$50 returned check fee will be applied for any returned checks due to non-sufficient funds or cancellations.

Refunds — There will be no refunds if cancellations are not emailed to show secretary prior to March 29, 2024 and will be approved at the show manager's discretion.

Dogs — Well behaved dogs are welcomed provided they are cleaned up after and kept on a leash. Rude dogs will be asked to leave the premises at the show manager's discretion.

Stalling — Every horse must be stalled. Stalling will be on a first come first serve basis with the exception of patron stalling. Patron stalling is on a limited basis and only available through the purchase of a patron package. Stall fees are \$100

Arenas — The Main Arena is 100'x200' with dirt footing and the warm-up arena is 80'x160' also with dirt footing, both with complete fencing. There will be no lunging in the main show arena during the show.

Bedding — No straw is allowed for bedding. Shavings must be purchased through the show at \$9 per bag with a minimum of two bags per horse stall.

Early Arrival — Early arrival (anything before 8 am Thursday April 11, 2024) can be purchased with entries at \$20 per day per horse entry form.

Parking/Camping — Parking is available on-site with no entry fees or permits. Camping is available at \$40 per night

Motorized Vehicle Statement — Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt.

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4 H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

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AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or in my custody or control.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition, and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, EC or USEF Equestrian permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s) qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the Arabian Horse Association and this Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

TBA Classes: Number of TBA slots are restricted to the type of class that be purchased; see class schedule. The following classes cannot be requested as TBA classes: Dressage, Western Dressage, Cow classes, Hunter Over Fences, and Jumper. TBA class purchase fee is \$25, in addition to the class entry fee, and must be received by the show secretary prior to close of entries. No addition post entry fee will be charged for TBA classes, only the normal class entry fee. The TBA purchase fee will be refunded if a minimum of 4 eligible and paid entries are received.

Select Amateur Adults: Regionals/Regular Competitions: a). Has not received more than 100 AHA Achievement points. b). Has not leveled out of the National Select Amateur Level.

Select Amateur Youth: Regionals/Regular Competitions: a). Has not received more than 150 AHA Achievement points. b). Has not leveled out of the National Select Amateur Level.

Youth Walk-Trot: Riders 10 and under. To be shown at the walk and trot or jog. Appropriate attire and equipment are required. Headers may be required for final line up. Riders may not have shown in any class other than other walk-trot classes or showmanship (any class that requires a canter or hand gallop). NO STALLIONS.

Adult Walk-Trot: Same rules apply for 19 and over.

Leadline: Riders who are at least two years of age and have not reached their seventh birthday. To be led at a walk by a person who is at least 14 years old. Saddle must fit rider and the rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons. Saddles may be equipped with hooded stirrups or breakaway irons. Leading rein must be attached to the cavesson or a halter placed under or over the bridal. Safety helmets with chin straps may be used by any rider, regardless of style or tack and or attire. NO STALLIONS.

Liberty: Two people permitted in ring (1 handler & 1 assistant). Music will be coordinated with the announcer. Halter is to be removed at the start of the music. Whips may be used but cannot touch the horse. The Liberty Class is scored on the freedom of movement, soundness and desire to move forward, which is natural to that horse. The music will stop at two minutes and the exhibitor has 2 minutes to then catch the horse. Glitter and other grooming are permitted. Cost of the class is \$20. Open Breed, Costume encouraged.

Egg & Spoon: This event is designed to portray the balance and coordination of the rider, while balancing an egg in a spoon. Egg must not be held with fingers, gum, or any other means; no shaking of the egg is allowed. Elimination will occur when the egg falls from the spoon. Winners will be determined by the last person to have egg in spoon. Class gaits and directions are at the discretion of the judge.

SCHOOLING CLASSES:

Western schooling — Western tack required. Curb bits, snaffles or bosals allowed. Running martingales allowed. Rider should be neatly dressed and wear boots with heels. Horses will be judged at the walk, jog, and lope both directions of the ring.

Hunter schooling — Hunter tack required. Running martingales allowed. Rider should be neatly dressed and wear boots with heels. Hunt cap or helmet required. Horses will be judged at the walk, trot, canter and hand gallop both directions of the ring.

Saddle Seat schooling — Saddle Seat tack required. Running martingales allowed. Full bridles or snaffles allowed. Rider should be neatly dressed and wear boots with heels. Horses will be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Opportunity Open Breed Classes | Also open to Arabians and Half-Arabians

Opportunity Open Breed Trail: The class will be judged of the performance of horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and quality of movement.

Opportunity Open Breed Reining: Rules and Regulations can be found in the Chapter RN Reining Horse Division RN101

Opportunity Open Breed Walk/Trot Pleasure: To be judged on attitude, manners, performance, suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation. To be judged on the rail at a walk and trot/jog both ways of the arena.

Opportunity Open Breed Showmanship All Ages: Handlers shall enter the ring in a counter clockwise direction on the rail unless otherwise specified by the judge. To enter at a walk or trot according to the judge's instructions. Each handler shall correctly lead their horse to and form the judge and show his/her horse according to instructions from the judge. Handler may be asked to perform additional test at the judge's discretion.

Opportunity Open Breed Ranch Horse Riding: The ranch riding class is to measure the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from ranch task to another. The horse should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working ranch horse riding outside the confines of an area. Each horse will work individually, performing both required and optional maneuvers and scored. The required maneuvers will include the walk, trot and lope both directions and the extended trot and extended lope at least one direction as well stop and back.

Opportunity Open Breed Western Horsemanship: Emphasis shall be placed on horse and rider working together. Execution and correct form of both horse and rider, while maintaining a pleasurable ride are the main criteria for this class. Rider must perform a pattern. Backing must be included in either the pattern or lineup.

Opportunity Open Breed Hunt Pleasure: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. To stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability as a Hunter, quality and conformation.

Opportunity Open Breed Equitation: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. To be judged on the rider.

Opportunity Open Breed Halter: Horses enter the ring at a walk or trot at the judges discretion. They are to line up on the rail and individually present their horse to the judge. Then they trot away from the judge and return to the line up.

Opportunity Open Breed Ranch Rail Pleasure: This class measures the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from one ranch task to another and should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working horse. Horse should enter at the walk or trot in either direction at discretion of the judge. Entries will be worked both directions of the ring at walk, trot, extended trot, canter and extended canter. The overall manners and responsiveness of the horse while performing the requirements and the horse's quality of movement are the primary considerations.

Opportunity Open Breed Western Pleasure: Horses are to be shown at a flat footed four-beat walk, free moving easy riding two-beat jog and a three-beat lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Extended gaits may be called for by the judge. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion.

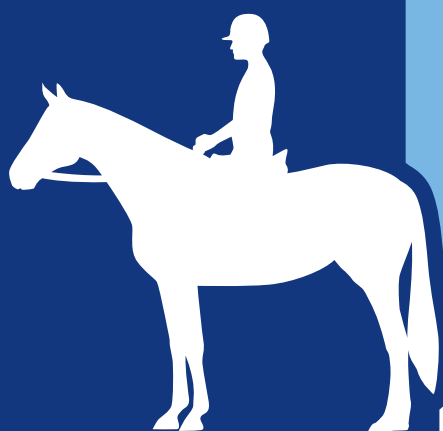
